I'm writing this letter for a few reasons. I feel like you all need to, at the very least, be updated as to where we sit for the upcoming season. This letter will probably raise a few more questions than it will answer, but that is the world we are in right now. Things are changing day to day, hour to hour, so anything I say in this letter could change and probably will. With that being said.... Here goes:

1. As of today, April 3, all of the city golf courses are closed. We will remain closed until the governor gives us the go ahead. Being a city run facility, we are mandated to do exactly what the governor says.
2. League Play- As of right now we are still expecting to have leagues at our facilities. There will be some drastic changes to how we would be able to gather. We are expecting to NOT be able to have our normal tournaments and gatherings (meetings) as we would in the past.

3. We will not be having the Icebreaker (spring meeting) this year. We will be in contact with the league boards to discuss other options for signing up.
4. The City of Rochester is working on how to handle Memberships for the 2020 season. Including what to do about members who may have purchased their membership last fall. None of this has been decided yet.
5. Daily Operation- We will be doing everything we can to make all of the facilities as clean and as safe as possible. We are in the process of getting an online payment option up and running.
6. When we do get the go ahead to open, we will need a little time to get the golf courses ready and get all procedures in place to keep everyone safe.

I will do my best to keep you all informed to the best of my ability. Unfortunately situations are changing so frequently that it's easier said than done. We appreciate your continued patience. We thought last year was tough..... Well hold on to your hats!!! We will definitely get through this and my hope is we come out on the other side as a stronger crew!!!
